

## Treatment for COVID-19

If you test positive today, you *might* be eligible for a treatment to prevent severe disease hospitalization, or death.

**This treatment can only be given within 10 days of symptom onset, so you need to take action right away!**

If you have a primary care provider, please contact his/her office to arrange for the treatment. If you don't have a primary care provider, please screen yourself with these questions.

**To be eligible for this treatment**, you must have at least ONE of these:

- Age over 64
- Have a body mass index (BMI) greater than 34. Calculate your BMI here:

- Have chronic kidney disease
- Have diabetes
- Have an immunosuppressive disease
- Be currently receiving immunosuppressive treatment
- Age over 54 AND have at least ONE of these:
  - Cardiovascular disease
  - Hypertension
  - COPD or other chronic respiratory disease
- Age 12-17 AND have at least ONE of these:
  - BMI greater than 84th percentile for your age and weight. Calculate your BMI percentile here:

  - Sickle cell disease
  - Congenital or acquired heart disease
  - Neurodevelopmental disorder, like cerebral palsy
  - Asthma that required daily medication
  - Reliance on technology such as a feeding tube or breathing machine

In addition to meeting the above criteria, you must also meet ALL of these criteria:

- Not on oxygen due to COVID-19
- Be at least 12 years old
- Weight at least 88 pounds
- Have a documented positive COVID-19 test
